











Anatomy Act in India: the anatomy act came into enactment in the year 1949 which has been adopted by all the states. It provides for the collection of dead bodies for teaching purpose, only if death occurs in a state hospital or in a public place within the prescribed zone of medical institutions, provided the police have declared a lapse of 48 hours that there are no claimants for the body and it could be used for the medical purpose.

Donating your eyes after death, then why not whole body?













## Appeal by the Department of Anatomy All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) Raipur CG India:

- \*Cadaveric dissection is the integral part of the anatomy curriculum of Medical Science and there is a strong need to popularize the message to common masses to donate their bodies after death for the teaching and research purposes.
- \*A person in his life can express his will for body donation in writing (Will form can be obtained from the Department of Anatomy) and can convince his next kith and kin about his / her pledging. The donor will be provided a 'Certificate of Honour' by the Institute.
- \*The dead body along with the death certificate should be transported within 6 hrs to the Department of Anatomy AIIMS Raipur. In case of delay in transporting, the body should be kept in mortuary or on ice slabs and if needed the Department of Anatomy AIIMS Raipur can provide a vehicle to transport the body within the Chhattisgarh state.
