The year 2013-14 witnessed fast paced development related to various activities of the institute. The first Batch of B.Sc. Nursing students (60 Nos) took admission in August 2013. The number of MBBS students increased from 50 to 100 for the 2013 batch. More faculty members of different streams joined the institute. This helped to enhance the quality of medical teaching and patient care services.

Clinical services were rolled out in a phased manner. This was a long felt need of the public of this region. Multi-specialty OPD services were started from 5th June 2013. The IPD services were also started from 26th December 2013. The institute had a very important milestone in its young history and this was the formal inauguration of AIIMS Raipur on 27th February 2014 by Shri Ghulam Nabi Azad, Hon'ble Union Minister for Health and Family Welfare, Government of India. Dr. Raman Singh, Chief Minister of Chhattisgarh was the Chief Guest of this occasion and it was also attended by other dignitaries, students, faculty members, staff and general public.

With the full support of Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India, the civil construction activities and purchase of high end equipment was also being expedited so that medical teaching, patient care and medical research of the highest order can be achieved.

INTRODUCTION



Introduction:

AIIMS Raipur is one of the new apex healthcare institutes established by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India under the Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojna (PMSSY) on the pattern of AIIMS, New Delhi. The institute was established with the aim of correcting regional imbalances in quality tertiary level healthcare in the region and attaining self sufficiency in graduate and postgraduate medical education and training in this hitherto under-served area of the country.

Mission Statement:

To establish a centre of excellence in medical education, training, health care and research imbued with scientific culture, compassion for the sick and commitment to serve the under-served. A mission to bestow world class services to the people of Chhattisgarh and surrounding areas in particular and the nation in the broader aspect.

Logo of AIIMS Raipur

The official logo of AIIMS Raipur presents the 2 serpents entwined around the Caduceus which was the Staff of Hermes (Mercury) in Greek Mythology. The staff is topped by a round knob and flanked by wings. The two serpents represent the pineal gland and the pituitary gland (which both look snakelike when uncoiled); the staff represents the spinal column; the knob represents the medulla; and the wings signify the two

hemispheres of the brain (the wrinkled cross-section of the brain has the shape and texture of stylized wings); the number of intersections of the snakes corresponds to the endocrine glands or the chakras.

It is believed that, the snake had magical powers associated with prophecy, dreams and healing. The Greeks also believed that the Gods appeared on earth in the guise of serpents. The Greeks, Egyptians and Hindus venerated the snake as the companion of Gods as the shedding of skin and renewal is emphasized as symbolizing rejuvenation.

The logo is amalgamated with the Sanskrit shloka -“Aarogyam Sukh Sampada” which has been taken up from the prayer of Goddess Lakshmi. It translates as “Hey Mother Lakshmi- Endow me with the blessings for my welfare, health and happiness”

Medical and Nursing Colleges

All the pre-clinical and para-clinical departments of the medical college viz. Anatomy, Physiology, Biochemistry, Pathology, Microbiology, Pharmacology, Forensic Medicine & Toxicology and Community & Family Medicine are functional and located in their respective earmarked spaces. The College of Nursing is currently functional from the Medical College building and is expected to be shifted to its location adjacent to the medical college building soon.



The Academic cum Examination Section was set up in April 2013 with Prof. (Dr.) S. P. Dhaneria as Controller of Examinations and Dr Krishnadutt Chavali as the Assistant Controller of Examinations.

The Section has been provided adequate space and infrastructure to conduct various examinations pertaining to the students.

Currently MBBS and B.Sc. (Hons) Nursing courses are being run. Postgraduate courses of MD, MS, MSc, PhD, etc. are being planned to be started subsequently.

The first batch of MBBS students was admitted in September 2012 with an intake of 50 students and the first Academic Session was inaugurated on 24th September 2012.

In July 2013, the First Professional Examination of MBBS (2012 batch) and subsequently the Supplementary Examination in September 2013 were conducted by the Academic Section. All students of the first batch (2012) were declared successful and promoted to the second professional year and their classes including clinical postings commenced from 12th August 2013. They are due to appear in their 2nd Professional year examinations in December 2014.

The second batch of MBBS students was admitted in August 2013 with an intake of 100 students and the Academic Session inaugurated on 1st August 2013. These students would be appearing for their 1st Professional examinations in July 2014.

- To get the various Audits like CCA Audit, CAG Audit etc conducted efficiently and effectively and to reply their paras in time.



Currently, the hospital and clinical departments are being run from the Trauma Centre, AYUSH-PMR building.

OPD services: Multi-specialty (Medicine, Surgery, Obstetrics & Gynaecology, Paediatrics, Pulmonary Medicine, Orthopaedics, ENT, Ophthalmology, Dermatology, Psychiatry and Dentistry) OPD services have been started from 5th June 2013. The OPD is run on all working days. Total numbers of patients benefitted by this service till 31.3.2014 are **59856**.



IPD Services: The total number of beds planned for the hospital is 960 with 30 sanctioned operation theatres. IPD services have been started from 26.12.2013. In the first phase, 160-bedded hospital is made functional with routine OT facility. Modular operation theatres (4 Nos), MGPS and CT scan (128 slice) facilities are under commissioning. CSSD will also be started soon. The procurement of equipment for Minimum Operational Requirement for 300 beds is being done by AIIMS, Raipur. The remaining Operation

Theatres will be made functional soon and major equipments are being purchased by a centralised process through M/s HLL Lifecare Ltd, Noida for all the six new AIIMS.

Total IPD census is **110** from the start date 26th December 2013 to 31st March 2014.


Minor OT started from date 26th February 2014 and 48 cases have been operated till 31st March 2014.

Twenty five (25) Senior Residents and eighty (80) Junior Residents and one hundred thirty six (136) Nursing Staff are currently working in the Institute.

Drug Store: A drug store is made available within the hospital premises, which offers all drugs prescribed by the doctors of AIIMS Raipur at 65% discount to the patients. The drug store is open round the clock.

Basic Life Support – A hands-on training workshop to impart skills in emergency life-saving procedures is being conducted by a team of faculty members of the Institute for students, staff, police and other security personnel, etc. The course is planned to train persons from other sections of the society to empower them with the knowledge and skills to deal with a medical emergency.

Telemedicine OPD: Telemedicine OPD services were started in collaboration with CRPF since 2nd April 2013. The service is being provided twice a week on every Monday and Thursday. This service specifically caters to the population of remote and inaccessible areas of Chhattisgarh, especially LWE (Left Wing Extremists) affected areas. **2227** patients from 22 Centres (CRPF) have benefited till 31.03.2014.



Diagnostic services: X-ray, ultrasound, biochemistry, pathology and microbiology tests are all available within the hospital at a nominal cost. The services are available round the clock. Specialized audio logical investigations have also been started. The numbers of investigations done upto 31.03.2014 are as given below:




Central Library



24. SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES AND NOTES TO THE ACCOUNTS.

1. ACCOUNTING CONVENTION

The financial statement are prepared on the basis of the historical cost convention, unless otherwise stated and on the cash method of accounting.

2. INVENTORY VALUATION

2.1 Stores and Spares (including machinery spares) are valued at cost.

2.2 Raw Materials, semi finished goods are valued at lower of cost and net realizable value. The cost are based on weighted average cost. Cost of finished goods and semi finished goods is determined by considering material, labour and overheads.

3. INVESTMENTS

3.1 Investments classified as “long term investments” are carried at cost. Provision for decline, other than temporary, is made in carrying cost of such investment.

3.2 Investment classified as “Current” are carried at lower of cost and fair value, Provision for shortfall on the value of such investments is made for each investment considered individually and not on a global basis.

3.3 Cost includes acquisition expenses like brokerage, transfer stamps.

4. FIXED ASSETS

4.1 Fixed Assets are stated at the cost of acquisition inclusive of inward freight, duties and taxes, incidental and direct expenses related to acquisition. In respect of projects involving construction, related preoperational expenses (including interest on loans for specific projects prior to its completion) form part of the value of the asset capitalized.

4.2 Fixed Asset received by way of non-monetary grants, (other than towards the Corpus Fund), are capitalized at values stated, by corresponding credit to Capital Reserves.

5. DEPRECIATION

5.1 Depreciation shall provided on w.d.v. method as per rates specified in the Income Tax Act 1961 expect depreciation on cost adjustments arising on account of conversion of

foreign currency liabilities for acquisition of fixed asset, after completion of warranty period, which is amortized over the residual life of the respective assets.

5.2 In respect of additions to/deduction from fixed asset during the years, depreciation is considered on pro-rata basis.

5.3 Asset costing Rs. 5000 or less are fully provided.

6. MISCELLANEOUS EXPENDITURE

6.1 Deferred revenue expenditure is written off over a period of 5 year it is incurred.

7. ACCOUNTING FOR SALES

7.1 Sales include excise duty and are net of sales returns, rebate and trade discount.

8. GOVERNMENT GRANTS/SUBSIDIES

8.1 Government grants of nature of contribution towards capital cost of setting up projects are treated as Capital Reserves.

8.2 Grants in Respect of specific fixed assets acquired are shown as a deduction from the cost of the related assets.

8.3 Government grant/subsidy are accounted on realizable basis.

9. FOREIGN CURRENCY TRANSACTION

9.1 Transactions denominated in foreign currency are accounted at the exchange rate prevailing at the date of the transaction.

9.2 Current assets, foreign currency loans and current liabilities are converted at the exchange rate prevailing as at the year end and the resultant gain/loss is adjusted to cost of fixed assets, if the foreign currency liability relates to fixed assets, and in other cases is considered to revenue.



10.1 Lease rentals are expensed with reference to lease term.


11. RETIREMENT BENEFITS

Separate Audit Report of the Comptroller & Auditor General of India on the Accounts of All India Institute of Medical Sciences, Raipur (Chhattisgarh) for the year ended 31 March 2014.

We have audited the attached Balance Sheet of All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), Raipur, Chhattisgarh as at 31 March 2014, the Income & Expenditure Account and the Receipt & Payment Account for the year ended on that date under Section 19 (2) of the Comptroller and Auditor General's (Duties, Powers & Conditions of Service) Act, 1971 read with section 18 (2) of the AIIMS Act, 1956 and the AIIMS (Amendment) Act, 2012. These financial statements are the responsibility of the AIIMS's management. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audit.

2. This Separate Audit Report contains the comments of the Comptroller and Auditor General of India (CAG) on the accounting treatment only with regard to classification, conformity with the best accounting practices, accounting standards and disclosure norms, etc. Audit observations on financial transactions with regard to compliance with the Law, Rules & Regulations (Propriety and Regularity) and efficiency-cum-performance aspects, etc., if any, are reported through Inspection Reports/CAG's Audit Reports separately.

3. We have conducted our audit in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in India. These standards require that we plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free from material misstatements. An audit includes examining on a test basis, evidences supporting the ~~amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. An audit also includes assessing the~~ accounting principles used and significant estimates made by management as well as evaluating the overall presentation of financial statements. We believe that our audit provides a reasonable basis of our opinion.

4. Based on our audit, we report that-

- (i) We have obtained all the information and explanations which to the best of our knowledge and belief were necessary for the purpose of our audit except the fixed assets register.
- (ii) The Balance Sheet, Income & Expenditure Account and receipt & Payment Account dealt with by this report have been drawn up in the format approved by the Ministry of Finance, Government of India.

(iii) In our opinion, proper books of accounts as required under section 18 (1) of the AIIMS Act, 1956 and other relevant records have been maintained by the AIIMS, Raipur in so far as it appears from our examination of such books.

(iv) We further report that:-

A Balance Sheet

A.1 Liabilities

A.1.1 Current Liabilities and Provisions (Schedule -7) ₹ 2.21 crore

The AIIMS, Raipur has neither deducted the employee's contribution nor made provision of ₹ 60.58 lakh for the Institute's share of pension contribution under New Pension Scheme since its inception. This resulted in understatement of Current Liabilities by ₹ 60.58 lakh and Expenditure by ₹ 53.56 lakh and understatement of prior period adjustments by ₹ 7.02 lakh.

AIIMS, Raipur has also not provided for other retirements benefits on actuarial valuation basis as required under AS-15 and instructions contained in the Uniform Format of Accounts (UFA).

A.2 Assets

A.2.1 Fixed assets (Schedule-8) ₹ 5.86 crore

A.2.1.1 This includes ₹ 33.53 lakh against which Journals amounting to ₹ 5.34 lakh only received upto March 2014. This resulted in overstatement of Fixed Assets by ₹ 19.73 lakh (₹ 33.53 lakh - ₹ 5.34 lakh - ₹ 8.46 lakh (excess depreciation charged)) and understatement of Loans and Advances by ₹ 28.19 lakh. This also resulted in overstatement of Expenditure of ₹ 8.46 lakh (₹ 10.06 lakh - ₹ 1.60 lakh) being excess depreciation charged.

B. Income & Expenditure Account

Income

B.1 Interest earned (Schedule-17) ₹ 89.24 lakh

B.1.1. This does not include ₹ 24.15 lakh being interest accrued on Fixed deposits. This resulted in understatement of income and Current Assets by ₹ 24.15 lakh.

Expenditure**B.2 Other Administrative Expenses etc (Schedule-21) ₹ 8.21 crore**

B.2.1 This includes ₹ 4.95 lakh being Imprest money given to officials. This resulted in overstatement of Expenditure by ₹ 4.95 lakh and understatement of Advance by the same amount.

B.2.2 This includes ₹ 1.97 lakh (₹ 46.92 lakh - ₹ 44.95 lakh) being depreciation under charged on Books/Journals. This resulted in overstatement of Fixed Assets and understatement of Expenditure by ₹ 1.97 lakh.

B.2.3 This includes ₹ 44.13 lakh being advance given to M/s HSCC India Ltd. towards maintenance of Residential Campus. This resulted in understatement of Advance and overstatement of Expenditure by ₹ 44.13 lakh.

C. Significant Accounting Policies and Note to Accounts (Schedule-24).

Policy no.1 (Schedule 24) that cash method of accounting has been followed by the Institute is not in consonance with the instructions contained in UFA, for maintaining accounts on accrual basis.

D General

1.2 The annual accounts of AIIMS, Raipur were not approved by the Governing Body. The Ministry of Health and Family Welfare authorized the Director to approve the Accounts.

Effect of Audit Comments on Accounts

The net impact of the comments given in the preceding paras is that the Assets, Liabilities, Income and Prior period adjustments were understated by ₹ 79.72 lakh, ₹ 60.58 lakh, ₹ 24.15 lakh and ₹ 7.02 lakh respectively and Expenditure was overstated by ₹ 2.01 lakh.

E Grant-in-aid

During the year, AIIMS, Raipur received Grant-in-Aid of ₹ 59.75 crore (₹ 27.00 crore in March 2014) and internal receipts amounting to ₹ 1.81 crore. In addition there was an unspent balance of ₹ 13.43 crore of previous year. Thus out of the total available funds of ₹ 74.99 crore, an amount of ₹ 26.82 crore was utilized leaving a balance of ₹ 48.17 crore (₹ 46.36 crore of Grant and ₹ 1.81 crore of internal receipts).

(v) Subject to our observations in the preceding paragraphs, we report that the Balance Sheet, Income & Expenditure Account and Receipt & Payment Account dealt with by this report are in agreement with the books of accounts.

(vi) In our opinion and to the best of our information and according to the explanations given to us, the said financial statements read together with the accounting policies and Notes on Account and subject to the significant matters stated above and other matters mentioned in the Annexure give a true and fair view in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in India.

a. In so far as it relates to the Balance sheet, of the state of affairs of the All India Institute of Medical Sciences, Raipur, Chhattisgarh as at 31 March 2014; and

b. In so far as it relates to the Income & Expenditure Account of the surplus for the year ended on that date.






