#### 3. UPPER AGE LIMIT:

- Upper age limit is 35 years as on 1<sup>st</sup>January 2022.
- Upper age limit is relaxable for OBC Candidates by a maximum of 3 years.
- Upper age limit is relaxable in case of SC/ST candidates by a maximum of 5 years.
- Upper age limit is relaxable for Ex-Serviceman and Commissioned Officer including ECO, SSCO who have rendered or released on satisfactory assignment with age relaxation by a maximum of 5 years.
- The persons with benchmark disabilities shall be given an upper age relaxation of five years for admission to DM/M.Ch for PWD candidates as per Right of persons with Disability Act, 2016.

A candidate who will be applying for two DM/MCh courses, he/she will have to appear for both the examinations. Additional time will be provided for the second examination.

#### 7. SCHEME OF EXAMINATION

The question paper will consist of 100 Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) of 2 hours duration. There is no negative marking. Scheme of marking will be as follows:

- o Correct Answer: One mark (+1)
- o Not answered: Zero mark (0)

#### 8. METHOD OF SELECTION

The percentile scores will be used to determine eligibility for admission. The candidate must secure 50<sup>th</sup> percentile mark to be eligible for admission. Merit list will be prepared as per percentile score.

#### 9. METHOD OF RESOLVING TIES

If two or more candidates obtain equal percentile score in the entrance examination then their inter-se-merit for admission to the course shall be determined on the basis of the following:-

- i. A candidate senior in age will rank senior to the candidate junior in age.
- ii. If the age is also the same, then a candidate who has obtained higher marks (Aggregate) in the MBBS examination will rank senior to a candidate who has obtained lesser marks.

#### 10. JOINING

Selected candidate is required to join on or before 15.03.2022. The competent authority may permit an extension of joining till 31.03.2022 based on merit of each case. In case the selected candidate fails to join by this date and no written request for extension is received by 31.03.2022, it will be assumed that he/she does not intend to join the course and the seat will be offered to the next candidate on the waiting list.

Last date for admission to the course will be 30.04.2022. In any circumstances, last date for admission will not be extended after 30.04.2022. This includes candidates on the wait list who may be offered a seat if the selected candidates does not join.

Candidates must bring their all requisite original documents along with one set of photocopy on the day of reporting.

- (C) The candidates are requested to fill the correct details regarding name/age/sex/caste/address/educational qualification and other relevant fields mentioned in the application.
- (D) Candidates may please note that unless they make the payment of Application Fee, their application will be treated as INCOMPLETE.
- (E) Payment of fee: Candidates can pay the application fee through NEFT. Additional charges viz. bank charges, service tax etc. incurred while making online payment of application fees will be borne by the candidate. ## 15. REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION OF OVERSEAS CITIZEN OF INDIA (OCI)

Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) registered under Section 7A of Citizenship Act 1955 are also eligible to appear in DM/MCh courses and all terms and conditions for Indian Nationals will be applicable to the candidates. The candidate will submit proof of Registration as OCI under Section 7A of Citizenship Act 1955 to be eligible to appear for this test.

## 16. SUBMISSION OF CASTE CERTIFICATE BY SC/ST/OBC/EWS CANDIDATES

- E. Administrator/Secretary to Administrator/Development Officer (Lakshadweep Island) or as authorised in the Constitution.

The candidate will be required to submit an undertaking to the effect of their caste. The detection of any discrepancy in the caste certificate shall entail cancellation of registration.
