**I. REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION OF "SPONSORED" CANDIDATES:**

- a. Candidates who are permanent employees of any Central/State Government/Armed Forces or the Public Sector Undertaking/Autonomous Body can be sponsored by the respective Government/Defence Authorities or the Competent Authorities of PSU/Autonomous Body.
- b. A State Government can sponsor candidates only for those Fellowship Programme which are not available in the State. **A certificate regarding non availability of the Fellowship (for which the candidate is being sponsored) in the concerned State, duly signed by the Secretary/Director General of Health Services of the Central / State Government/ DGAFMS/Competent Authority or PSU/Autonomous Body viz. Director/Executive Head of the concerned organization, should be furnished in the format prescribed for this purpose.**

- c. All eligible "sponsored" candidates will be called by the Institute for the entrance test.
- d. Seats as shown in the prospectus are available for "sponsored" candidates. Sponsored candidates will be designated as "PDCC Fellow".
- e. The subject for which the candidate is being sponsored should be clearly specified in the sponsorship form by the sponsoring authority. The candidate can be sponsored for only one subject. **The applications of those candidates who are sponsored for more than one subject will not be considered.**
- f. No "Sponsored" candidate will be paid any emoluments by the Institute during the training period. Such payments will be the responsibility of the sponsoring authority (i.e. Central/State Government or Defence Authorities).
- g. Sponsored candidates **must submit/send sponsorship certificate in original** from their employers in the following format along with the application form to the **Examination Section, Second Floor, Medical College Building, Gate No. 5, AIIMS Raipur, Tatibandh, Raipur.** (Those who fail to do so should submit it before the date of issue of Admit Cards as mentioned under "AT A GLANCE" in the Prospectus failing which their candidature will be cancelled).

## II. For Non-Sponsored Candidates:

The candidates must have completed the requisite qualification, degree and tenure by 31.08.2024. The candidates who are likely to complete their 3 years requisite qualification, degree and tenure after 31.08.2024 are not eligible to appear in this examination. Any wrong information provided by candidate on same may invite disciplinary action including debarment from future examination.

### 3. UPPER AGE LIMIT:

- Upper age limit is 45 years as on 31<sup>st</sup> July 2024.
- Upper age limit is relaxable for OBC Candidates by a maximum of 3 years.
- Upper age limit is relaxable in case of SC/ST candidates by a maximum of 5 years.
- Upper age limit is relaxable for Ex-Serviceman and Commissioned Officer including ECO, SSCO who have rendered or released on satisfactory assignment with age relaxation by a maximum of 5 years.
- The persons with benchmark disabilities shall be given an upper age relaxation of five years for admission to PDCC for PWD candidates as per Right of persons with Disability Act, 2016.

#### NOTE:

1. For the purpose of application fee, the candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC (NCL)/EWS/PWBD category, the candidate must possess a certificate issued by competent authority (as applicable to category/format provided by AIIMS Raipur).
2. OBC (NCL) certificate must be issued within one year of last date for **application 16.08.2024 (i.e. issued between 16.08.2023 to 15.08.2024).**
3. EWS certificate should be issued on or after on 01.04.2024 to last date of filling of application form i.e. 16.08.2024 based on the income of year 2023-2024.

### 4. DURATION OF COURSE:

The tenure of the PDCC course is one (01) years from the date of joining the course.

**7. SCHEME OF MARKING:**

The question paper will consist of 100 Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) of 2 hours duration. **There is no negative marking.** Scheme of marking will be as follows:

- Correct Answer: One mark (+1)
- Not answered: Zero mark (0)

**8. METHOD OF SELECTION:**

The percentile scores will be used to determine eligibility for admission. **The candidate must secure 50<sup>th</sup> percentile mark to be eligible for admission.** Merit list will be prepared as per percentile score.

**9. METHOD OF RESOLVING TIES:**

If two or more candidates obtain equal percentile score in the entrance examination then their inter-merit for admission to the course shall be determined on the basis of the following:-

- i. A candidate older in age will rank senior to the candidate younger in age.
- ii. If the age is also the same, then a candidate who has obtained higher marks (Aggregate) in the MBBS examination will rank senior to a candidate who has obtained lesser marks.

**10. JOINING:**

Selected candidate is required to join on or before 15.09.2024. In case the selected candidate fails to join by this date, it will be assumed that he/she does not intend to join the course and the seat will be offered to the next candidate on the waiting list.

Last date for admission to the course will be 30.09.2024. In any circumstances, last date for admission will not be extended after 30.09.2024. This includes candidates on the wait list who may be offered a seat if the selected candidates does not join.

## 12. HOW TO APPLY:

- (A) Candidate can apply **Online**.
- (B) Applicants must fill all the fields **carefully** since after submission of online application request for change in any information at any later stage will **not** be considered.
- (C) The candidates are requested to fill the correct details regarding name/age/sex/caste/address/educational qualification and other relevant fields mentioned in the application.
- (D) Candidates may please note that unless they make the payment of Application Fee, their application will be treated as INCOMPLETE.
- (E) **Payment of fee:** Candidates need to pay the application fee through Online. Additional charges viz. bank charges, service tax etc. incurred while making online payment of application fees will be borne by the candidate. **Candidates are advised to take a print of the receipt of fee of Application Form for their records and future reference.**
- (F) Admit Card will be downloaded using Login ID and Password from the AIIMS Raipur Website well in advance of the date of examination.
- (G) Payment of application fees by any other mode viz Cash, Cheque, Money Orders, Postal Orders, Pay Orders, Banker's Cheques, Postal Stamps, etc., will not be accepted. Such applications will be summarily rejected. The decision of Director, AIIMS Raipur in this regard shall be final and binding and no refund will be issued against such payment.

## 13. APPLICATION FEE:

### MODE OF PAYMENT - Online

- General/OBC Category: 2500/- + Transaction Charges as applicable
- SC/ST/EWS Category: Rs. 2200/- + Transaction Charges as applicable.
- PWBD Candidates is exempted from Fee.

Candidates are advised to make sure to get the confirmation of the successful remittance by their bank and retain the proof of the same which may be required at the time of document verification. The application fee is non-refundable.

## 14. REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION OF OVERSEAS CITIZEN OF INDIA (OCI)

Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) registered under Section 7A of Citizenship Act 1955 are also eligible to appear in PDCC courses and all terms and conditions for Indian Nationals will be applicable to the candidates. The candidate will submit proof of Registration as OCI under Section 7A of Citizenship Act 1955 to be eligible to appear for this test.

**15. SUBMISSION OF CASTE CERTIFICATE BY SC/ST/OBC/EWS CANDIDATES:**

The candidates who belongs to category, has to submit attested copy of Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe, Other Backward Classes and EWS as applicable, along with other requisite documents, from any one of the following **authorities stating that the candidate belongs to Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribe, Other Backward Classes or EWS in the prescribed form.**

- A. District Magistrate, Additional District Magistrate, Collector, Deputy Commissioner, Additional Deputy Commissioner, Deputy Collector, 1<sup>st</sup> Class Stipendiary Magistrate, City Magistrate, Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Taluka Magistrate, Executive Magistrate, Extra Assistant Commissioner.
- B. Chief Presidency Magistrate/Additional Chief Presidency Magistrate/ Presidency Magistrate.
- C. Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar.
- D. Sub-Divisional Officer of the area where the candidate and his or her family normally resides.
- E. Administrator/Secretary to Administrator/Development Officer (Lakshadweep Island) or as authorised in the Constitution.

The candidate will be required to submit an undertaking to the effect of their caste. The detection of any discrepancy in the caste certificate shall entail cancellation of registration. This is as per the provisions made by Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions vide their order No. 36033/4/97-Estt. (RES) dated 25.07.2003 and No. 36011/3/2005-Estt. (RES) dated 9.9.2005 respectively.

**Candidates must note that a certificate from any other person/authority will not be accepted and no further correspondence in this regard shall be entertained. The name, designation and the seal of the officer should be legible in the certificate.**

**16. REASONS FOR REJECTION/CANCELLATION OF APPLICATION:**

APPLICATIONS/CANDIDATURE OF APPLICANTS ARE LIABLE TO BE CANCELLED/REJECTED SUMMARILY OR AT ANY STAGE OF THE ADMISSION PROCESS IN THE EVENT OF ALL OR ANY OF THE FOLLOWING:

- i. Applications being incomplete.
- ii. Any variation in the Signatures.

All the SIGNATURES in FULL (NOT IN SHORT) done on the Print out of the Application Form and also on other Documents must be the same.

- iii. The photograph and signature pasted/uploaded in the application form is blur, distorted or not clear.
- iv. Non-payment of Examination Fees or non-receipt of fee through online mode, if not otherwise exempted.
- v. Under aged/over aged candidates.
- vi. Failure to bring (**in original**) all relevant Certificates/Documents issued by the competent authority, along with self-attested legible copies in support of the information given in their Application Forms about their Educational Qualifications; Experiences; Percentage of Marks obtained; Proof of Age; Proof of Category [SC/ST/OBC] and the print out of Application Form at the time of verification of document.
- vii. Not having the requisite Educational Qualification/Experience/Category Status as on the closing date.
- viii. Incorrect information or misrepresentation or suppression of material facts.
- ix. For carrying mobile phones / accessories in the Examination premises/Hall.
- x. Any other irregularity.


## 17. ACTION AGAINST CANDIDATES FOUND GUILTY OF MISCONDUCT:

- (A) Candidates are warned that they should not furnish any particulars that are false or suppress any material information while filling in the application form. Candidates are also warned that they should in no case attempt to alter or otherwise tamper with any entry in a document or the attested certified copy submitted by them nor should they submit a tampered/fabricated document. If there is any inaccuracy or any discrepancy, an explanation regarding this discrepancy should be submitted.
- (B) Without prejudice to criminal action/debarment up to 3 years from examinations conducted by AIIMS, Raipur wherever necessary, candidature will be summarily cancelled at any stage of the admission in respect of candidates found to have indulged in any of the following activities:-
- a) In possession of mobile phone and/or accessories and other electronic gadgets within the premises of the examination centers, whether in use or in switched off mode and on person or otherwise.
  - b) Involved in malpractices.
  - c) Using unfair means in the examination hall.
  - d) Obtaining support for his / her candidature by any means.
  - e) Impersonate/ procuring impersonation by any person.
  - f) Submitting fabricated documents or documents which have been tampered with.
  - g) Making statements which are incorrect or false or suppressing material information.
  - h) Resorting to any other irregular or improper means in connection with his/her candidature for the examination.
  - i) Misbehaving in any other manner in the examination hall with the Supervisor, Invigilator or supporting staff of AIIMS, Raipur.
  - j) Intimidating or causing bodily harm to the staff employed by AIIMS, Raipur for the conduct of examination.

## 18. OTHER IMPORTANT POINTS

- i. Please fill the Application carefully. It may not be possible to make changes after submission of application. Applicants may note that further correspondence will NOT be entertained in this regard.
- ii. Any Amendment/Rectification/Change/Editing is NOT allowed in Name, Category, Department and PWBD status once submitted. Any change in address, mobile no. and email ID should be intimated to this office immediately.
- iii. **The Competent Authority reserves the right of any amendment, cancellation and changes to this admission notice as a whole or in part without assigning any reason or giving notice.**
- iv. In case, any information given or declaration by the candidate is found to be false or if the candidate has willfully suppressed any material information relevant to his/her admission, he/she will be liable to be removed from the institute and any action taken as deemed fit by the competent authority.
- v. The decision of the competent authority regarding selection of candidates will be final and no representation will be entertained in this regard.
- vi. **Name of the selected/eligible candidates will be displayed in the institute website. No separate individual intimation will be sent.** Beside, all information regarding examination will also be provided through the Institute website only. The Institute will not be responsible in any manner if a candidate fails to visit / access the website in time. - xiii. Private practice in any form during the course is prohibited. The period of training is strictly full time and continuous.
- xiv. The rules are subject to change in accordance with the decision of the Institute to be taken from time to time.
