**NEET UG – COUNSELLING FOR ADMISSION TO MBBS
COURSE – 2026 SESSION -**

STUDENTS REPORTING TO AIIMS RAIPUR

On behalf of AIIMS Raipur, I would like to congratulate you and your family on your success.

1. These instructions are only for the candidates who will be/are allotted to AIIMS Raipur for admission to MBBS course by Medical Counseling Committee (MCC), DGHS for the year 2026 and freeze their seats & report to AIIMS Raipur.
2. Please read the instructions provided by MCC regarding the process of reporting and taking admission. As per the schedule of Medical Counseling Committee (MCC), the candidates who are allotted AIIMS, Raipur & freeze their option are required to report to AIIMS Raipur, to complete the admission formalities. Candidates are advised to regularly visit MCC website (www.mcc.nic.in) for any update about reporting dates.
3. **Venue for Reporting: 4th Floor, A-Block, New Administrative and Academic Building, AIIMS Raipur.**
4. **Following activities are required to be completed by candidates freezing their seats during 1st Round & 2nd Round Counselling:**

Admission/Hostel Fee Submission	As per reporting dates given by MCC (03:00 to 05:00 PM)	After being found Medically Fit for admission to MBBS course by the Medical Board, student has to deposit the requisite fee i.e. Rs. 5856/- .

Hostel Allotment	As per reporting dates given by MCC (03:00 to 05:00 PM)	i. Only for those students, who confirms their seat at AIIMS Raipur (students not opting for upgradation) and who have completed verification of their documents and found OK. Their Medical Fitness Test will be done on same day as per timing given. ii. Hostel will be allotted only to those students who confirms their seat, found medically fit, and paid the requisite fee.
Start of Academic Session	9th September 2026	This is the tentative date for the start of academic session for MBBS 2026 batch.
Orientation Programme	-	Detailed Schedule will be issued later.

Note: i. These dates are tentative and may change as per MCC, DGHS instructions.

ii. On Sundays and Govt. Holidays, Medical Examination, Admission/Hostel Fee Submission and Hostel Allotment cannot be done. It will be done next working day.

iii. Medical Examination, Admission and Hostel Fee submission, and Hostel Allotment is not available on Saturdays, Sundays and Government Holidays and will be available on next working day.

5. **Eligibility Criteria will be same as per AIIMS New Delhi.** All the candidates are instructed to read the Prospectus of MBBS 2026 available at <https://aiimsexams.ac.in/advertisement/6a798281f753e1515340be42> for eligibility criteria and other details for admission to MBBS courses at AIIMS Raipur.

6. **Eligibility**

- Age:** Candidates should be born before 1st January 2010 i.e. Candidates born on or after 1st January 2010 are **NOT ELIGIBLE**. Candidates should have attained or will attain the age of 17 (Seventeen) years as on the 31st of December of the year of admission (2026).
- Essential Academic Qualification:**
 - Candidate should have passed 12th Class under 10+2 Scheme/Senior School Certificate Examination (CBSE) or an equivalent Examination of a recognized university/board of any Indian State with **English, Physics, Chemistry and Biology** as subject.
 - Candidates, who have appeared or appearing at qualifying examination with **English, Physics, Chemistry and Biology** as main subject and expect to pass the Examination with required percentage of marks are also eligible to apply and appear in the Competitive Entrance Examination. However, their candidate will be considered only if they provide documentary evidence of having passed the qualifying examination with the required subjects and percentage of marks.

iii. **Minimum Percentage/Marks:**

- The minimum aggregate of marks in **English, Physics, Chemistry and Biology** obtained in qualifying examination:
 - **General (UR), OBC (NCL), EWS Candidates: 60%**
 - **SC/ST Candidates: 50%**
 - **PwBD Candidates: 45%**
- Those with CGPA grades only will have to apply the conversion factor in the application form. The conversion factor should be as approved by the respective examination board.
- **Note: The Minimal Marks in essential qualification for AIIMS are different from those prescribed by MCC for other Medical Colleges (See Information Bulletin and Counseling Scheme for NEET UG 2026 of the MCC)**

7. Candidates should bring following documents/certificates **in original** at the time of reporting **along with one set of self-attested photocopies of all these documents/certificates:**

NOTE: Students/Parents are advised to keep the scanned copy of their Original Documents (10th/12 Marksheet/Certificate, Category Certificate).

i. **Fill the Google Form.**

- i. Provisional Seat Allotment Letter issued by MCC
- ii. Admit Card of NEET 2026 Exam issued by NTA – **Original Print, Not Photocopy**
- iii. NEET/NTA Scorecard - issued by NTA **in Original Print, Not Photocopy**
- iv. Certificate of having passed the 10+2 or equivalent examinations, showing the subjects offered by him/her in the Examination.
- v. Certificate from the Board form which he/she passed the High School/Higher Secondary Examination, showing his/her date of birth.
- vi. Certificate/Marks sheet from the Board form which he/she passed the 10+2 or equivalent examination showing that he/she has secured 60% or more marks (50% in case SC/ST persons & 45% for person with Benchmark Disability) in aggregate in English, Physics, Chemistry and Biology.
- vii. Class 12th Migration Certificate issued by University/Board last attended by candidate.
- viii. Five (5) Passport size photograph same as uploaded/affixed on the NEET UG 2026 application form.
- ix. Proof of Identity (Aadhar Card/PAN Card/Passport/Driving License – Aadhar card is preferable) – **Please carry photocopy of identity proof.**
- x. Category Certificate (OBC (NCL)/SC/ST/EWS) as applicable should be issued **as per format** available at AIIMS New Delhi prospectus.
 - a. **SC/ST certificate** issued by the competent authority. Community should be clearly mentioned in the certificate.
 - b. **OBC (NCL) Certificate** should be issued by the competent authority. The sub-caste should tally with the **central list** of OBC. OBC candidates should not belong to Creamy Layer. OBC (NCL) certificate must be in the prescribed format.

- c. **EWS certificate** should be issued by the competent authority and must be in the prescribed format.

Note:

1. The OBC (NCL) should be issued from 1st April, 2025 (inclusive) and start of reporting of Round-1 of MBBS counseling as notified by Medical Counselling Committee (MCC) for MBBS admission will be considered valid for admission to NEET (UG) 2026.
 2. The EWS Certificates should be issued from 1st April, 2025 (inclusive) and start of reporting of Round-1 of MBBS counseling as notified by Medical Counselling Committee (MCC) for MBBS admission will be considered valid for admission to NEET (UG) 2026.
 3. All the certificates should be either in English or in Hindi language only. In case the certificate is in regional language, the candidate should carry an Attested translated copy of the certificate in English/Hindi.
- xi. **Disability (PWBD) Certificate** – Disability Certificate issued from prescribed authority showing that he/she belongs to Persons with Benchmark Category along with the medical assessment from the designated medical assessment centres/boards by applicable.
- xii. Relieving Letter (if upgraded in from previous round)
8. Those candidates who join MBBS course at AIIMS, Raipur, his /her all original certificate will be retained and the same will not be returned to the candidate before completion of the course.
9. Fee to be deposited at the time of reporting/admission.
- i. **Indian Nationals:** Total fee ₹ 5,856/- (Rupees Five thousand eight hundred fifty six only) is to be paid at the time of reporting/admission by **UPI/Debit/Credit cards** only. Breakup of fee to be paid is given below:

This fees are for the entire duration of the course (4 ½ years) and is charged on a one-time basis at the time of admission.

- ii. Foreign Nationals:** Tuition Fees of US \$ 75,000/- (divided in 3 equal installments for Pre-clinical phase, Para clinical Phase, Clinical Phase of MBBS course) will be charged from the foreign national students admitted to MBBS course at AIIMS Raipur.

- 10. Mess Fee:** The mess fee will be as per actual as per the agreement between the institute and by Mess Contractor from time to time. **Ordinarily, Mess fees is around ₹ 4000 per month and subject to revision time to time. It is compulsory for the students to have foods (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner) in the institute's Mess only. Mess Fee is compulsory for all students irrespective of whether they avail mess facility or not.**
