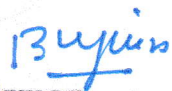

3. 10. The Member Secretary presented the recommendations of the SSC interviews for the recruitment of various faculty posts through direct recruitment held from 24 to 26 July 2025. Details are attached as Annexure - II.

11. The GB Members discussed the agenda in detail, covering the methodology, procedure, attendance of the SSC Members (both in person and through VC) and involvement of subject matter experts in the selection process.

Agenda Item No: GB 14/08**Approval of the Governing Body, AIIMS Raipur to revoke para concerning implementation of minimum qualifying service required for promotion in the RRs of 2015 for non-faculty posts at AIIMS Raipur.**

13. The 10th GB, held on 22.05.2023, approved the matter presented vide Agenda Item 10/03 regarding the use of Recruitment Rules (RRs) 2015 for recruitment, in line with directions received vide MoH & FW OM dated 30.03.2023. Simultaneously, a DoPT OM dated 20.09.2022, pertaining to the revision of the minimum qualifying service required for promotion based on the recommendations of the 7th CPC was also made applicable along with the RRs 2015.

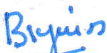
14. The Member Secretary informed the GB that the above mentioned MoH & FW OM neither mentioned nor mandated applicability of the above cited DoPT OM to AIIMS. However, it was unnecessarily applied the same, resulting in confusion, delays, hardship to employees and potential legal issues concerning promotions. He requested the GB that the DoPT OM dated 20.09.2022 should be withdrawn.

15. Dr. Surjit Singh inquired whether this approach aligns with other AIIMS. The Member Secretary confirmed that other AIIMS have not implemented this DoPT OM and no directive(s) has been issued by the Ministry mandating its implementation at AIIMS Raipur.

16. Shri Hoveyda Abbas sought clarification on the qualifying criteria for promotions. The Member Secretary clarified that the RRs 2015 already define the criteria laid down for promotion. He added that application of both the DoPT OM and RRs 2015, simultaneously, leads to inconsistencies and inequities in terms of qualifying service for promotion(s). Therefore, the Institute must follow a single set of rules to avoid further confusion and litigation(s).

17. Shri Abbas further inquired whether revoking the DoPT OM would have any financial implications, especially since it was implemented on 22.05.2023, post approval in 10th GB meeting. The requirement of funds might not have been reflected in the GIA (Salary) budgets for FY 2023-24 and FY 2024-25. He requested that the financial impact be assessed. The Member Secretary clarified that there would be no financial implications arising from the revocation of the DoPT OM as its implementation was neither mandated by the Ministry nor retrospective promotions are permitted under current rules. He further clarified that following the withdrawal, all future promotions will be governed by the minimum qualifying service criteria as prescribed in RRs 2015.

18. The Governing Body, taking note of the clarification(s) and submission(s), approved the agenda.

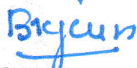
Submission of mercy petition by Shri Phool Singh, Senior Nursing Officer (terminated) - requesting reconsideration of major penalty imposed upon him w.r.t the disciplinary proceedings and final order in sexual harassment Case.

20. The Member Secretary along with the Deputy Director (Administration) and the Dean (Academics), who also served as the ICC Chairman in this case, briefed the GB in detail regarding the case of Shri Phool Singh, Senior Nursing Officer (terminated) and his subsequent mercy petition submitted to the GB, being the Appellate Authority.
21. The Member Secretary requested the GB to deliberate further on the agenda item, in the light of the mercy petition filed by Shri Phool Singh and consider revoke or alter the penalty imposed, if deemed fit.
22. After due deliberation, the GB recommended obtaining a legal opinion before taking any final decision regarding the reinstatement of Shri Phool Singh. Also, it was suggested that the views of the victim be considered, keeping in mind the potential scrutiny by a court / commission in future, to ensure that the Institute's position be legally sustainable.
23. The GB decided to defer the agenda till next meeting.

Agenda Item No: GB 14/11

Approval of engagement of Junior Residents against vacant posts of Senior Residents.

24. The GB, considering the genuine requirement of additional posts of JRs to facilitate smooth functioning of the hospital and efficient patient care services, noted that there would be no financial implications in engaging the proposed posts of JRs (Level 10) against the sanctioned posts of SRs (Level 11) on a temporary basis.
25. Accordingly, the GB approved the agenda.

Agenda Item No: GB 14/12**To consider the promotion of employees affected by the changes in the Recruitment Rules (RRs) from time to time at the Institute.**

26. AIIMS Raipur was established in the year 2012. Since its inception, the MoHFW has made multiple changes to the applicability of Recruitment Rules (RRs) at the Institute.

27. Over time, two sets of RRs have been made applicable to AIIMS Raipur, as under :-

- (a) Recruitment Rules (RRs) of AIIMS New Delhi.
- (b) Recruitment Rules (RRs) 2015 for all new AIIMS.

28. The period of applicability of these RRs at AIIMS Raipur is detailed below :-

29. Recruitments at AIIMS Raipur have been conducted in accordance with the RRs in vogue at the various times. While candidates were appointed as per these prevailing RRs, frequent changes in the applicable RRs have significantly impacted the career progression of employees. These changes have led to considerable delays in promotions, resulting in professional stagnation and financial losses for the affected employees.

30. Furthermore, the Institute has been facing persistent recruitment and promotion bottlenecks due to the changing RRs. Employees across various cadres, despite having rendered adequate service, have not been granted promotions, thereby hindering their career growth.

31. In the absence of adequate promotional avenues, several employees have filed legal cases against the Institute. These litigations have further delayed both direct recruitment (DR) and promotional processes, adversely impacting the smooth functioning of the Institute. As a result, promotion, recruitment conducted at the level of Institute and by CRE (Common Recruitment Examination by AIIMS New Delhi) for the posts of Junior Administrative Officer (JAO) and Senior Administrative Assistant (SAA) are currently on hold due to pending court cases. There are also court cases against the post of Assistant Engineer, Assistant Administrative Officer and Personal Assistant.

32. Notably, the RRs of AIIMS New Delhi were made applicable to AIIMS Raipur from 10.12.2018 to 21.05.2023. During this period, promotion avenues were opened for several posts. However, the subsequent reversion to the RRs of 2015 has once again disrupted these opportunities.

33. The details of employees / posts impacted by the current RRs 2015 are provided below. These employees would get promoted to the next available cadre if relaxation, in line with the AIIMS New Delhi RRs, is granted :-

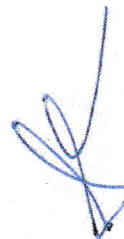
34. As a result of following RRs 2015, the following has happened :-

- No fresh recruitment is being done in DR vacancies as there are six stay orders from court on the subject.
- Existing cadre cannot be promoted as there are not enough promotional vacancies.

35. Net result Institute is suffering.

36. In case we revert back to AIIMS New Delhi RRs the following benefits accrue :-

(a) A large number of existing cadres (feeder cadre being adequate) will get opportunity for promotion in DPC.

(b) The junior vacancies arising out of their promotion will be filled by DR, thus accomplishing the aim of Mission Recruitment.

37. Therefore, the GB unanimously agreed to revert back to AIIMS New Delhi RRs, subject to it being approved by the MoH & FW.

38. Shri Hoveyda Abbas suggested that a comprehensive proposal on the subject, indicating number of employees affected, financial implications etc, be forwarded to MoH & FW for consideration.

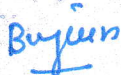

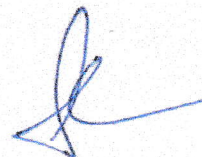
(a) To consider incorporation of the provision of a Bond / Affidavit by the selected candidate(s), applicable for the duration of probation or 2 (two) years from the date of joining, in the Offer Letter by the Institute to discourage resignation, thereby leaving the post(s) vacant even after arduous and time-consuming recruitment procedures and to ensure staffing stability in the Institute for efficient functioning. Proposed Bond amount(s) are as under:-

(b) To consider the approval of Institute Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) Policy: AIIMS, Raipur has established SRIJAN (Scientific Research and Innovation Junction for AI and New Biomedical Research) under the chairmanship of Executive Director and CEO, with the objective of fostering a culture of innovation, AI-driven biomedical research, and technology development. One of the key mandates of SRIJAN was to draft a comprehensive Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) Policy for AIIMS Raipur. Accordingly, a draft IPR Policy was prepared, drawing upon, as under :-

(i) Guidelines issued by the Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR), and

(ii) Best practices from AIIMS Delhi, AIIMS Rishikesh, IIT Roorkee and other premier institutions.

(iii) The draft policy underwent several rounds of review and refinement with the Chairman, Dean (Academics), and Dean (Research). The final draft has been placed for the consideration of the GB, as under :-

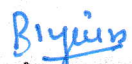
(aa) **Scope and Applicability.** Covers patents, copyrights, trademarks, designs, trade secrets, know-how, and all IP generated by faculty, staff, students, researchers, and collaborators.

(ab) **Ownership Norms.** Institute-owned, joint/shared ownership for collaborative/sponsored research, and creator-owned where developed without significant institutional resources.

(ac) **Institutional Mechanism.** Establishment of an IPR Management Committee (IPRMC) with powers to evaluate, file, commercialize, resolve disputes, and monitor implementation.

(ad) **Disclosure & Confidentiality.** Mandatory innovation disclosure through Invention Disclosure Forms; confidentiality obligations throughout the evaluation and protection process.

(ae) **Commercialization Pathways & Revenue Sharing.** Defined mechanisms for institute-led or creator-led commercialization. Revenue sharing: 70% inventor/creator, 10% Department/SRIJAN, 20% Institute.

(af) **Support for IP Filing.** Institute-funded filing and maintenance (national/international) with legal and patent attorney support.

(ag) **Academic Freedom.** Encouragement for publication and dissemination while safeguarding commercial potential.

(ah) **Students' Research.** Joint ownership of copyright in theses, with provisions for confidentiality and patent support.

(aj) **Conflict of Interest & Indemnity.** Mandatory disclosures and safeguards to protect both the Institute and inventors.

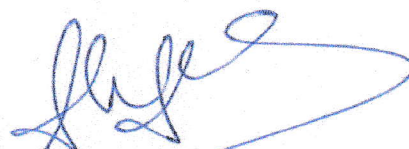
(ak) **Legal Jurisdiction.** All agreements and disputes subject to the jurisdiction of the High Court of Chhattisgarh.

(iv) Shri Hoveyda Abbas agreed with the same and suggested that the same also be got vetted by the DHR and also recommended formation of a section 8 company in line with guidelines on the subject being implemented in various INIs.

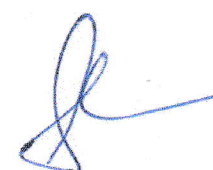
The GB concurred the above agenda and agreed for processing the case as discussed.

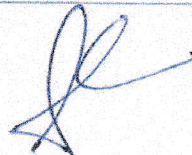

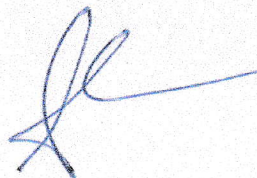
